

# BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS MINUTES NOVEMBER 7, 2024

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Helton made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 3, 2024 meeting. The motion received a second from Mr. Messer and passed with a unanimous vote.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

### CASE 24-05 – LAVISH SALON AND SPA REQUESTS A USE DETERMINATION – 541 BELLE AVENUE.

Mr. Divel explained that this request is to determine if cosmetic tattooing, commonly referred to as permanent make-up, constitutes a personal service/salon use. The commissioners discussed the differences between this use and traditional tattooing. The applicant addressed the commission, explaining that the pigment used for permanent make-up does not go as deep as the ink used for traditional tattooing. Additionally, the application is semi-permanent in nature and requires touching up after a few years. The commissioners cited the equipment and processes, semi-permanence and ancillary nature as distinctive features separate from traditional tattooing.

## **Action Taken**

Mr. Roberts made a motion to define the use as a personal service, based on the semi-permanent nature of the pigment, which should be allowed as an ancillary use for an existing salon. The motion received a second from Mr. Fox, with all voting in favor except Mr. Stott, who voted against.
